

To submit a funding request to Fondazione Marcegaglia, it is necessary to send the required documentation to info@fondazionemarcegaglia.org no later than October 31st.

1. Cover Letter:

- Brief introduction of the applicant organisation
- Summary of the project/initiative for which funding is requested from the Foundation
- Indication of the amount of funding requested from the Foundation

2. Project / Initiative Proposal:

- A single structured document including:
 - Title of the project/initiative
 - Objectives (general and specific)
 - Intervention context and identified needs:
 - Problem analysis (supported by data and sources)
 - Target beneficiaries (direct and indirect) of the project/initiative:
 - Profile of beneficiaries
 - Expected number
 - Planned activities:
 - Description of actions to be implemented
 - Methods and approach used
 - Timeline of planned activities
 - Expected results and impact indicators:
 - Qualitative and quantitative results
 - Monitoring and evaluation indicators
 - Composition of the team responsible for project/initiative implementation
 - Involved stakeholders:
 - Roles and contributions of any partners or other local entities
 - Sustainability strategy:
 - Any plans for self-financing, replicability, or scalability

3. Financial Plan / Budget:

- Detailed budget of the project/initiative:
 - Expected expenses (personnel, materials, logistics, communication, etc.)
 - Expected revenues (including any co-financing)
 - Amount of funding requested from the Foundation

4. Documentation on the Applicant Organisation:

- Statute or articles of incorporation
- Brief description of the organisation:
 - Mission
 - Intervention areas and territories
 - Main beneficiaries
- Most recent Social Impact Report / Annual Activity Report
- Most recent approved financial statement (including explanatory notes)
- Relevant previous experience, in particular:
 - Projects already carried out on female empowerment or related areas (e.g., training and employment inclusion of vulnerable people, economic autonomy, combating gender-based violence, etc.) in the same geographical context or other contexts
